

"... the Kyoto emissions reductions will only delay the temperature increase about six years in 2100, as was evident in figure 157. Put very simplistically, the world ends up paying for the trouble from global warming twice over - first, every year from 2050 we pay 2 percent of GDP for cutting CO₂, and when reaching 2100 we pay 2 percent more because of higher temperatures which are almost unaffected by the Kyoto Protocol."
